Main Aggregates of general Government

Statistics Portugal presents the 2007 estimated data of the Main Aggregates of General Government transmitted to Eurostat according to the ESA95¹ transmission programme.

The data is consistent with the first Excessive Deficit Procedure notification of 2008. The table below presents a summary of the non-financial general government accounts.

The general government accounts are compiled according to the concepts and definitions of ESA95, complemented with the guidance of the Manual on government deficit and debt (MDD)² and Eurostat recommendations and Decisions. For some treatments it is also taking into account specific advices from Eurostat following member states consultations.

^(a) According to Commission Regulation (EC) N° 351/2002, amending Council Regulation (EC) N° 3605/93 as regards references to ESA 95, the classification of interest flows under swap contracts and forward rate agreements (FRAs) has a specific treatment for the data transmitted under the excessive deficit procedure. This approach has impact in the difference between the Balance Net lending (+)/Net borrowing (-) according the European System of National and Regional Accounts (ESA95) – B.9 and the balance under the excessive deficit procedure EDP-B.9.
