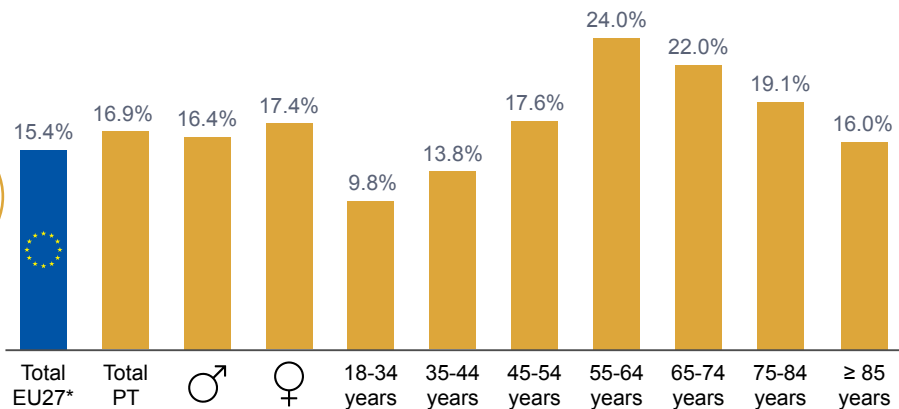

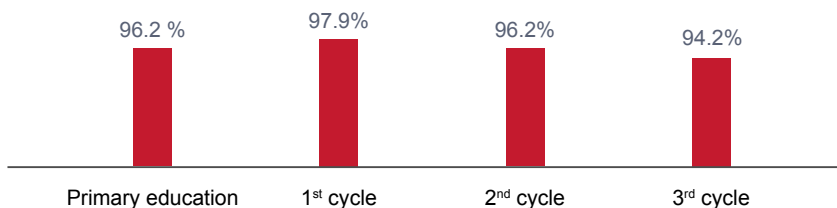

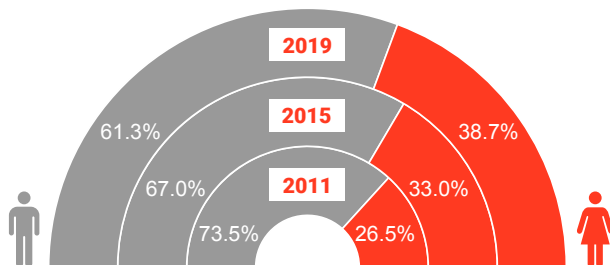

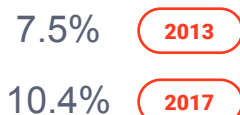

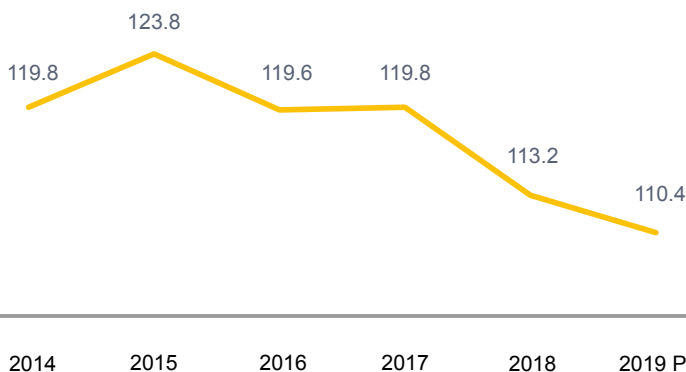

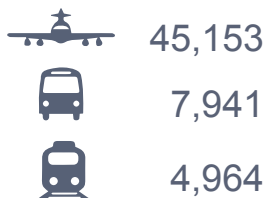

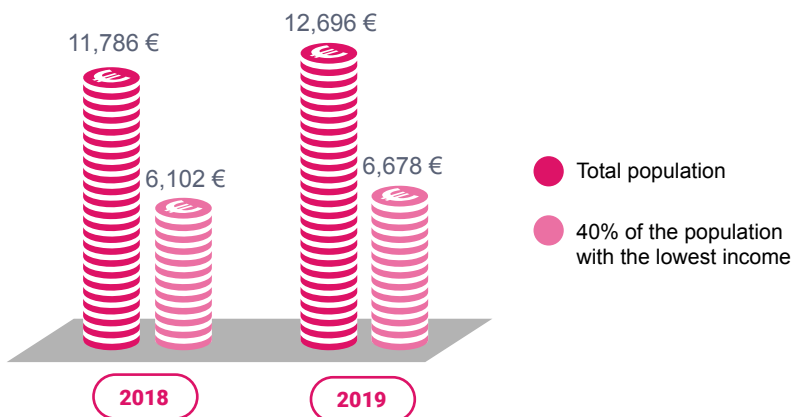

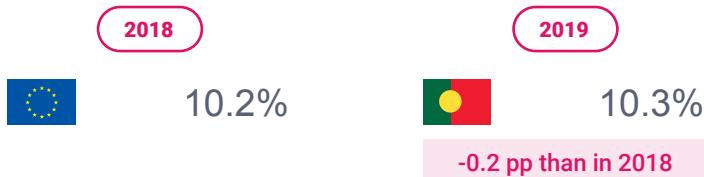

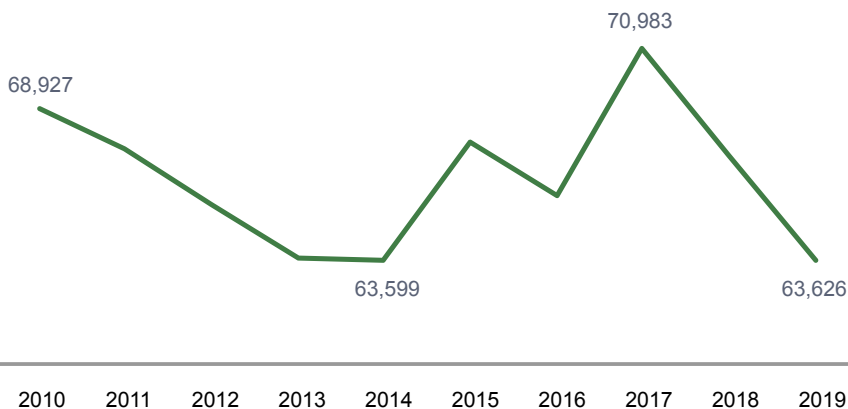

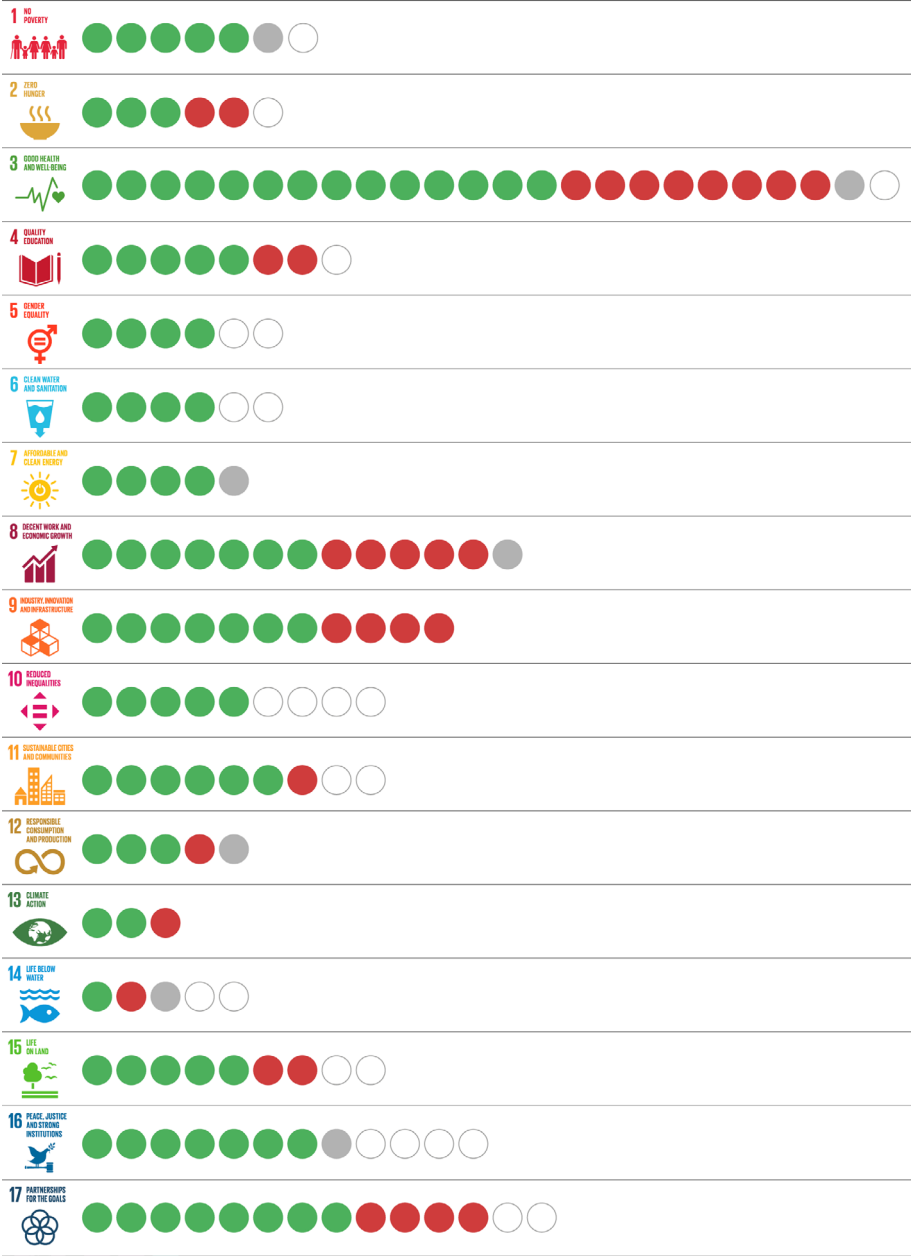

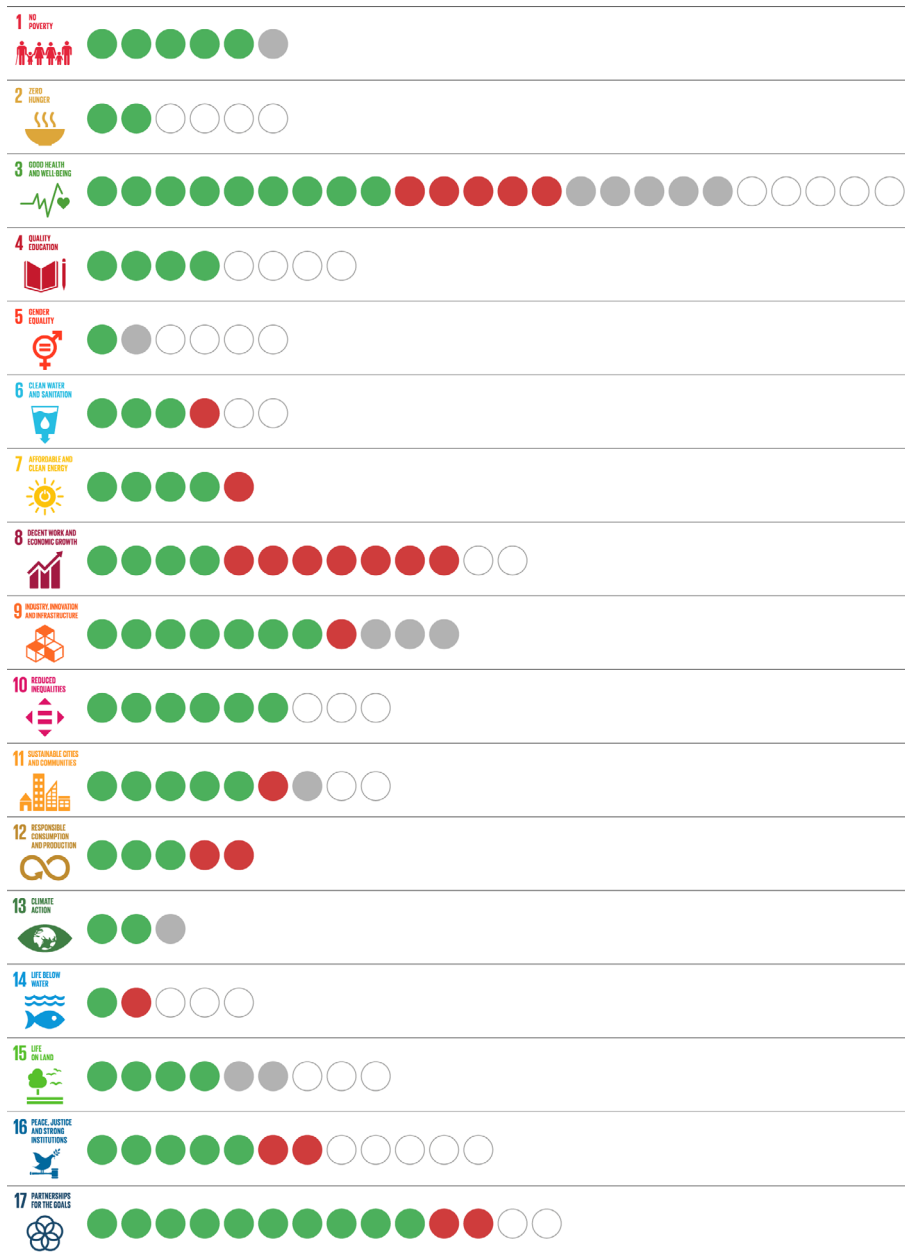
SDG indicators evolution in Portugal in the period 2010-2020 *
